Please read ALL THE RULES before submitting an application.

Contest Guidelines:

1. Must be a resident of Waipahu, Hawaii who are ages 5 to 17 at the time of entry are eligible to enter.
2. One entry per student.
3. Participants must create a poster entry that best illustrates “THE PRIDE OF WAIPAHU” past, present and/or future.
4. Artwork must be on an 8.5 x 11 inch sheet of unlined, white paper and no thicker than a poster board.
5. Student may use art media: marker, ink, paint, crayon, photography, or collage.
6. Must be artist’s original work.
7. Please include the theme of the poster: “The Pride of Waipahu”
8. No collaborative entries (i.e.: assistance from adults in creating their artwork - exception: if other people will be used in photographs)
9. Securely attach an index card with artist’s name, age, school, and email.
10. The Perpetuating “The Pride of Waipahu” Poster judging will take place prior to the event and winners will be announced and artwork will be displayed at the Celebrate Waiaphu 120 Finale Event on November 18, 2017 at August Ahrens School. Winners will be notified before the event by Committee.
11. Decisions of the winners for each award is final.

Divisions:

Entries will be grouped by Grade Level:

- Elementary Grades K-3
- Elementary Grades 4-6
- Intermediate Grades 7-8
- High School Grades 9-12

Awards will be distributed in each division!

- 1st Place - \$200 cash prize
- 2nd Place - \$125 cash prize
- 3rd Place - \$75 cash prize

Additional prizes will be awarded for runner-ups each division!
